Chocolate Pie (makes two)

1-1/3 c. sugar

4 T cocoa (heaping)

4 T flour

1/2 c. milk

2 cans pet condensed milk

4 egg yokes

1/2 c. warm water (mix with egg)

1 tsp. vanilla

Mix sugar, cocoa and flour. Add pet milk, egg yolks and water. Add vanilla. Cook until mixture is thick sauce.

Pour into 2 baked pie shells.

Cool.

Top with egg white or Cool Whip.

Quick Tip: A leaf of lettuce dropped into the pot absorbs the grease from the top of the soup. Remove the lettuce and throw it away as soon as it has served its purpose.

O Scale News **Bruce Herring**

Anyways, with the limited space that the sites we are looking at that we can afford, O scale will likely not support a Thomas display. There just isn't room for it if we want a regular O scale functioning layout. Whatever size building the Club secures, O scale wood be looking to occupy 10-20% of that space. So if the total space is 2,500 sq. ft., then O scale would be looking at 250—500 sq. ft.

I have also been thinking about table construction. A 4 x 8 piece of plywood could be cut into thirds giving you three 32" x 48" table tops. These would be fairly lightweight and easy to get in and out of doors with normal sizes.

Lastly, at a recent meeting Paul Falk did some on-line research into Train Clubs searching for new homes. Let's just say we are not alone. I'll let Paul fill in those details.



Back in February, CMRC was hoping to get access to Suite 100 at the mall to host the Miami Valley Modular rail club in October. We all know how that turned out.




